From the Board President

Hopefully this newsletter finds you healthy and ready to enjoy some time at the lake. While the creek is flowing again, hopefully we will have some spring rain to raise the lake level this year. There was not any snow on the ground when I went to the cabin in February, so we will need some rain this year.

I have been in communication with the MNDNR regarding the dam on Big Pine Lake. It is in need of repair or replacement. The fisheries department of the MNDNR favors having fish passage in a new structure. If we have fish passage, there is funding available (how much and when is the big question). There is no funding available for repairing the existing concrete structure. I am continuing to have conversations with the MNDNR. More information on the dam repairs should be available by the Spring Board meeting.

I have continued to attend the Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) monthly meetings. As mentioned last year, an invasive to watch for is Spiny Water Flea. They have been detected in Lake Mille Lacs, so the fear is that they could be transported to Big Pine Lake. It looks much like cotton when it attaches to fishing line. Mille Lacs also has Mystery Snails, another invasive species. Last year during Starry Trek, a search organized to look for the Starry Stonewart invasive species, I saw large amounts of Mystery Snails along the shoreline of Lake Mille Lacs.

The board officers for 2024 are Tom Hubbard-President, Mike Moore, Vice President, Sharon Esnough, Treasurer, and Mary Lin Gmach, Secretary for the Board.

The Spring Board meeting is scheduled for May 18th, 9:00 AM at the Big Pine Lake Chapel.

We plan to continue our traditional events for 2024. Check the dates for the events in this newsletter. 
